1	MATTHEW'S GOSPEL	Study of the Life of Jesus, examining His teaching, training, of the 12, His trial, crucifixion, resurrection & ascension.
2	TRAINING LEADERS IN CHILDREN'S MINISTRY	Building the church by effectively reaching out to children.
3	PAULINE THEOLOGY	A brief study on the major teaching & doctrines of Paul the Apostle.
4	OLD TESTAMENT HISTORY/SURVEY I	Creation & the beginnings of mankind. Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph & Moses (Genesis to Deuteronomy).
5	DOCTRINE OF MAN, SIN & SALVATION	What the Bible teaches about Man created innocent in God's image, his fall into sin, the nature of Sin, and the way of Salvation: faith, repentance, justification, redemption, re-birth, and sanctification.
6	POETIC BOOKS	A survey of the poetic writings in the Old Testament & its relevance in Scripture & our walk with God.
7	JOHN'S GOSPEL	The purpose of John - "that you may believe..." A study of the "I Am's" of Christ, the "Upper room discourse", His death, resurrection & appearances.
8	DOCTRINE OF CHRIST	A study of the person of Jesus Christ - His humanity & His deity. A study on the meaning & importance of Christ's atoning death, His resurrection & ministry in heaven.
9	DEFENDING OUR FAITH	A study of Christian apologetics to enable believers to give & answer as to why they believe the Bible. (Mukhanyo Notes)
10	NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY I	Survey of Gospels
11	EVANGELISM & DISCIPLESHIP	The presentation of the Gospel, Crusade & Personal Evangelism, Steps in leading a soul to Christ, Helping a seeker to overcome barriers. Encouraging the new believer to grow in faith, worship, obedience & service.
12	WOMEN OF THE BIBLE	An in-depth look at womanhood in Scripture applied to today.
13	ACTS	The birth & growth of the Church. The work of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers like Peter, Phillip, Stephen & Paul. The missionary journeys of Paul & his final trip to Rome.
14	DOCTRINE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT	Studies of the Spirit as a Person, His deity, His baptism, the fullness of the Spirit, His gifts & fruit.
15	MISSIONS	What the Bible teaches about missions & what God wants from His Church today.
16	OLD TESTAMENT HISTORY/SURVEY II	Studying the Biblical Times from Samuel to Solomon.
17	DOCTRINE OF GOD & ANGELS	Nature of God, His Names & Attributes, The Trinity. Angels - good & bad, including Satan.
18	LETTER TO THE HEBREWS	The finality of the work of Christ. (Mukhanyo Notes)
19	1 CORINTHIANS	A study of how Paul helped a weak church with many problems.

21	AFRICA IN CONTEXT	A course dealing with the African realities & the Church. (Mukhanyo Notes)
22	CHURCH PRINCIPLES	Direct Lordship of Christ, authority of Scripture, Priesthood of all believers, etc.
	STEWARDSHIP	Living the responsible life, caring for God's things, Giving.
23	1 TIMOTHY, PASTORAL MINISTRY & CHURCH GROWTH	Study of 1 Timothy as related to work of a Pastor, Visitation & Counselling, His public ministry, his family, Principles of Church growth.
24	EXODUS	Deliverance from slavery & the Christian's relationship to the Ten Commandments.
25	ROMANS	A study of Paul's presentation of the basic teachings on the Gospel, emphasising chapters 1-8.
26	CULTS & OTHER RELIGIOUS SYSTEMS	Evaluation of teachings of Jehovah Witnesses, Mormons, Seventh Day Adventists, Roman Catholics, Liberals, Zionists, Animists, Islam, Hinduism, Excessive Practices.
27	SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES	Developing a consistent & growing relationship with God as a believer.
28	OLD TESTAMENT HISTORY/SURVEY III	Major Prophets. Understanding their message in context & its relevance for today.
29	HOW TO STUDY THE BIBLE (HERMENEUTICS)	How to interpret Scripture & make accurate application.
30	BIBLICAL LEADERSHIP	Studying the leadership style of Biblical leaders, seeking to find principles on how to lead effectively.
31	BIBLICAL COUNSELLING	A framework for pastoral counselling with an African mindset.
